The Rotary Club of St. Louis Park was founded in 1947 and its 90 members are the primary supporters of the Foundation. Foundation funds are derived from club fundraising, such as an annual pointsettia sale and from the generous contributions of our members.

In St. Louis Park, Rotary has had a lasting impact. Our club provided the impetus for the creation of St. Louis Park's nationally acclaimed Children First initiative, encouraging wide-spread community support of youth. The club launched Operation Jump-start, a mentoring program at the alternative high school. Other organizations it has supported include STEP, youth baseball and the Senior All Night Party.

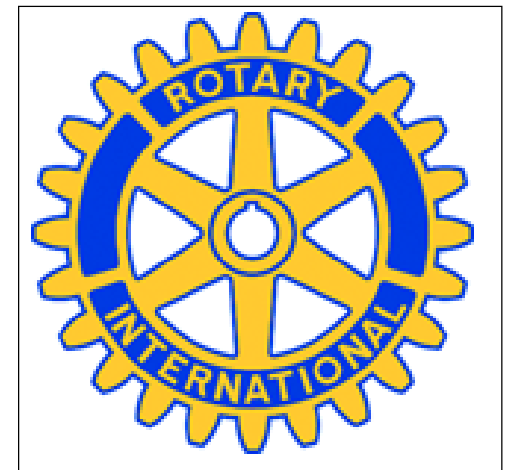

The Rotary Foundation gives grants to:

- Organizations that are located in St. Louis Park and, through this grant, serve primarily people who live in St. Louis Park.
- Organizations located outside of St. Louis Park, and through this grant, will serve primarily people who live in St. Louis Park.
- Non-profits, schools, community organizations, and the city.

The Foundation does not give grants to:

- Individuals
- Political candidates or causes.
- Religious organizations requesting money for religious activities.

If your organization meets the criteria above, use this form to make your request. The St. Louis Park Rotary Foundation accepts grant requests throughout the year. This is a competitive process; requesting a grant does not assure you will receive one. The Foundation receives more requests for grant money than it has available.

## Grant Request

Please answer the following questions on a separate sheet of paper. To ensure the Foundation Board can understand your request, please type your application.

1. What is the project to be funded? Please describe.
2. Who will be served? Where do the people who will be served live?
3. Summarize other fundraising efforts for this project.
4. Explain why the St. Louis Park Rotary Foundation is being asked to contribute.
5. Explain who will benefit from this contribution and how.
6. Attach a project budget including time and materials.
7. Describe how the project will proceed if the St. Louis Park Rotary Foundation does not contribute or only contributes a portion of your request.
8. Provide a projected timeline for the implementation of the project.
9. Are you requesting direct Rotarian involvement? If so, how?
10. Is there anything else you would like the Foundation to know about your request?
